- A round of golf with cart and paragolf equipment at Long Reef Golf Club located on the beautiful Northern Beaches
- Drinks with Club President and Foundation Chair (subject to availability)
- Lunch for two people at The White Rock café at Long Reef Golf Club

Founded in 1921, Long Reef Golf Club's course has a well-earned reputation of being one of Sydney's best golfing layouts. One of Australia's greatest golfers and course designers, British and Australian Open winner Peter Thomson, rated Long Reef as "the best site of any golf course in Sydney".

John Mullins OAM was a long standing and dedicated supporter of Long Reef Golf Club in many roles, including that of President. He was instrumental in having the golf club involved with the development of Sargood in numerous ways.

In recognition of the ties, in particular the consistent and deeply valued relationship between Long Reef Golf Club and the Sargood Foundation, two grants will empower guests fond of golf and living with spinal cord injury to enjoy golf once again.
