Sargood Foundation Accommodation Grants

The Sargood Foundation's vision is that all people affected by Spinal Cord Injury are provided with every opportunity to live life to the fullest.

We genuinely want to make a positive difference in the lives of those living with Spinal Cord Injury. A visit to Sargood on Collaroy is so much more than respite, it is life transforming and works to create new futures and opportunities for those who live with the trauma of Spinal Cord Injury, as well as their families.

Our guests can enjoy the company of others, as well as having access to the incredible team of nurses and support workers, the occupational therapist and exercise specialists and of course, the chance to participate in some life changing activities.

The Sargood Foundation will consider providing an Accommodation Grant to support a stay at Sargood on Collaroy for a person living with Spinal Cord Injury who meets the following criteria:

- Those aged over 65 who are not covered by the NDIS, nor are they covered by state based insurance
- Those who have sustained a recent Spinal Cord Injury and are waiting for the allocation of NDIS or insurance funding
- Those whose NDIS plan is insufficient to cover a stay at Sargood on Collaroy
- Consideration will be given on a case by case basis to fund an additional interconnecting room to accommodate family members or carers for guests who are not covered by NDIS

Available only to residents of Australia, preference will be given to applicants that can demonstrate financial hardship and individuals will be limited to one stay in a three-year period as available funds need to be shared equitably among all eligible guests.

The recipients of the grants will be selected from applicants at the discretion of the Sargood Foundation.
