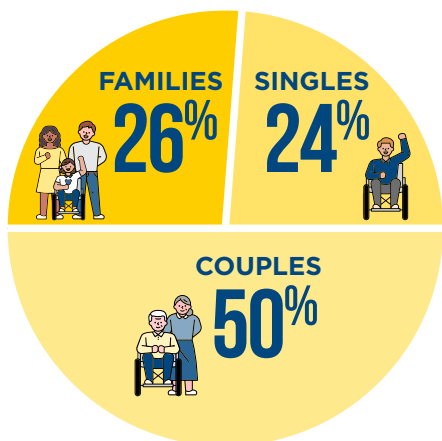

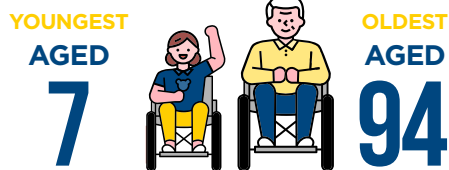
Sargood on Collaroy opened in 2017.



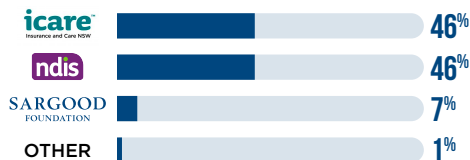

We have hosted **800+** guests, providing outstanding clinical care in a non clinical environment

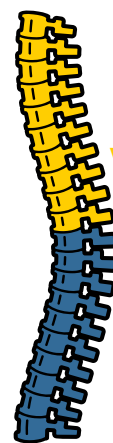


Majority of our guests are from NSW. We've also welcomed international visitors.
